Alcohol may be supplied by families for consumption with refreshments. A corkage charge of £5.00 per bottle (75cl) will be applied.

The above prices do not include disbursement fees paid on your behalf for example doctor's fees, crematorium, Church, officiant, flowers and newspaper notices.

We will require a deposit payment for the full cost of disbursement costs a minimum of 3 working days prior to the funeral taking place with the balance of the account invoiced approximately 7 days after the funeral requiring payment in 30 days from the date of invoice, after which you may be charged interest until payment is received in full. We are not approved to offer payment plans.

## DISBURSEMENT CHARGES – PRICE LIST 2021

We have no control over these charges, but do make every effort to make your life easier by paying them in advance on your behalf to enable the funeral to go ahead while you only have to make one payment. Some of these costs are optional and some you cannot avoid depending on your choice of funeral. A funeral should be personal and there is a vast array of choice and options available. We have tried to include the most commonly chosen options, but we are happy to advise on costs or other details for anything outside of what you read below. Our intention is to give you the full picture of potential costs to help you make an informed choice, where others may hide those costs until it's too late. The prices below are correct at the time of publish but are subject to change at any time.

### **Cremation**

Following the cremation, you will need to consider what to do with the cremated remains. Some, but not all options may incur further costs. Please ask for advice.

### **Burial**

#### *Cemetery*

These costs vary hugely from place to place and some authorities charge different rates for residents and non-residents if they allow the burial of a non-resident at all. Whether or not you already own a plot there are interment fees to pay in addition. Sometimes that includes the cost of the grave digger sometimes that is a further expense.

#### *Churchyard*

Fees are set by the diocese so should be uniform across all churchyards. It is not possible to purchase a plot as such (unless a faculty is granted which is rare), but a burial takes place in the churchyard and the plot remains the property of the church.
